

KEYS Academy Dress Code

This list is not all-inclusive. Final determination of acceptable dress and grooming rests with the Principal and his designees.

No sagging / baggy pants.



No torn or ripped jeans or clothing.



Ear spacers/plugs are not allowed.



Plain white undershirts, hoodies, or any indecent/inappropriate patches, writings, or drawings on clothing are prohibited.



Beards are not allowed. Mustaches must be well groomed. No facial hair below the lips is permitted. Sideburns must not extend below the lower edge of the ear lobe.



Non-Instructional Items

CD players, laser pointers, radios, MP3 players, video or audio recorders, DVD players, personal laptops, cameras, games and other similar items are prohibited at school.



Cell phones shall not be turned on or used during the school day. Cell phones must remain out of sight throughout the school day. No cell phones will be permitted on campus during State Mandated TAKS testing dates.

Liquid paper, paint pens, permanent markers are not allowed.

No chains or spiked bracelets, rings or chokers. Jewelry/accessories considered dangerous are prohibited.



No sleepwear or slippers.



Unconventional colored, multicolored, spiked or mohawk hairstyles are not permitted.



No low-cut or strapless blouses.



No sleeveless, spaghetti strap or racerback tops.



Skirt length must be no shorter than 3" above the knee, even with leggings.



No face or tongue piercing on any student. Traditional ear piercings are allowed on girls.



No hats, caps, skullcaps, bandanas and other headgear. Sunglasses are not permitted during the instructional day.

Any apparel that distracts from the learning atmosphere will be considered inappropriate. Cleanliness, neatness, and good taste are the standards by which school personnel judge appropriate dress. Any apparel or unusual accessory that distracts from school decorum is not acceptable as appropriate dress for school.
